

Greenwood Craftsman

651 NW 89th St: \$459,950



This 1937 Craftsman-inspired remodel incorporates familiar touches: natural cedar shingles, and wide, overhanging eaves with traditional eave brackets. Inside, windows are rimmed with capitol moldings and walls have beadboard wainscoting; outside, Bluestone hardscaping inspires a relaxing feel. Living room, dining room, and kitchen open into each other, drawing guests in. Brazilian cherry in the living room becomes floor tile in the dining areas, and a cook's island is the locus of the entertainment. The kitchen boasts abundant counter space, shelves and cabinets. Stainless steel appliances are offset by a backsplash of 1.5-inch-square tiles, in a warm brown. Emphasis is on the natural, the comfortable, and the welcoming.

Further in, the main-floor bedrooms are bright and cheery, with wood floors and large, room-width closets. Downstairs, the two-room suite is lined with berber-weave, wheat-colored carpet. A second full bath rounds out that living space, and finished wooden beams complete the look. With a spacious concrete patio for outdoor entertaining, a brickwork path leads to a "Craftsman shed" in the back, which could be playhouse, guest quarters, or writer's den.
